Discussion of Rules:

- 1. Stop Clock in Last 5 Minutes if Winning team Substitutes
- 2. Improperly equipped player must leave the field if they cannot resolve the problem on the field.

 They can sub for this player and if they choose not to the player can return on the next dead hall
- 3. You can use one hand when gesturing play-on
- 4. When play is stopped for unusual situation or injury the game must be restarted with a drop ball. If the keeper has control of the ball it is an indirect free kick and it must leave the goal box. If keeper does not have control inside the goal area referee should drop ball at the top of the goal area closet to where the ball was when play stopped. Referee does not determine who takes the drop ball. A drop ball is indirect and is complete when the ball is touched twice.

Points of Emphasis:

- 1. Pregame Communication between school administration and officials
- 2. Communication on Cards with Coaches and Table

Reminders:

- 1. Home Team should be wearing dark jersey and Away team solid white jerseys
- 2. Anything holding up socks must be of like color except for ankle guards
- 3. No jewelry for players and referees
- 4. On injury check with player before stopping the clock
- 5. Should be at the field 30 minutes before the game
